

# Factory crackles with creativity

**I**SLINGTON Arts Factory crackles with creative energy. It is currently staging the third Metamorphose exhibition, for which 20 postgraduate students at Byam Shaw School of Art explored the theme of Memory individually and collaboratively.

Works include a washing line hung between the pillars of this converted Victorian church.

The artists collaborated with children on IAF's MakeArt programme to make a mini-washing line of postcards to absent friends.

Helium balloons with the children's Wishes – pouches made of fabric and grain – float below the 60ft high ceiling of the gallery.
